And whereas Board members are instrumental in helping students better their lives and pursue their dreams, and are thus, literally, dream-makers;


And whereas the Board has conducted successful fundraising campaigns and gone to great lengths to improve the quality of education at the college;


And whereas these same Board members serve without remuneration, humbly donating their extremely valuable time to a worthy cause;
