I have been told from time to time that the political abuses of the govern- are all in the past. Read the following and ask your self if, you like us, believe that the government has a disruption and disinformation campiang go- ing on, orif these things are just coincidences. Two days before Leonard went to his parole hearing another prisoner assaulted him and tryed to pro- voke him in to a fight. Even though Leonard did not retaliate he was placed in the hole. Then the day after the hearing he was transfered to a prison in Oklahoma City. There he was told that he would later be sent to a prison in Atlanta, GA, where he would be held in solitary the full time in that prison. Then he was transfered to the medical facility in Springfield, MO. There maybe a number of reasons,for him going to Springfield; thousands of people made calls of protest to the transfer, it may have dawned on the government that it was not a good idea to send Leonard to a prison in the same town where the summer Olympic games are to be held with all the inter- national press that will be there, or it could just be that the government decided to give Leonard the medical attention that he has long needed. But things do not end there. On the internet and faxes being sent to radio sta- tions (and maybe other places) a disinformation campaign has taking place that stated that Leonard has been granted parole. The fact of the matter is that, as of this writing, no such thing has happen. DO NOT BELIEVE IN- FORMATION THAT DOES NOT COME FROM LEONARD, THE LPDC, REGIONAL COORDINATORS, OR LOCAL SUPPORT GROUPS! Unfortunatly alot of people were hooked by this and helped pass on this disinformation. The reasons behind all this are very likly that the government wanted to tie up the LPDC with the transfers and disinformation to sabotage the Feb. 6th "20 Years of Injustice" actions at FBI offices. We here with the NW Network have help to get the word out and we have gotten a number of responsesback saying that it was a good idea, but since he was getting paroled it was nolonger needed. Also, our mail has been interfered with. All of this makes the Feb. 6th actions even more im- portant!
