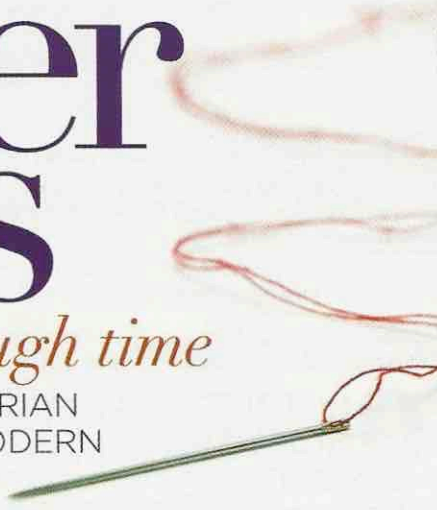

Grand Farms is a full-care boarding and training facility that is home to head trainer Anni Grandia Dodsun. Training specializes in 3-Day Eventing, with each program tailored to the individual horse and rider. They also provide lessons to brand new riders and introduce them to horses.

The farm consists of 26 acres with an indoor arena with a new sand surface and roof, outdoor grass jumping arena, acres of trails and a cross country course with water complex. They also boast a heated viewing area, amenities for riders with disabilities, and work with Easter Seals of Washington in the summer months.

Additionally, Grand Farms hosts an extensive conference and wedding events venue and the very popular Haunted Forest in the fall.

The community garden land is owned by Lakebay Community Church whose congregation has grown partnerships with the Hope Recovery Center addiction treatment program and the Seeds of Grace garden programs to feed the hungry. The Community garden started in March of 2017 with 12 raised beds, a garden shed, and a self-sustaining solar panel system, all of which were constructed by more than 100 volunteers from the church and their partners.

The Community Garden is the first project for the property with plans to enlarge the site and for it to become a component of the Hope Recovery Center.

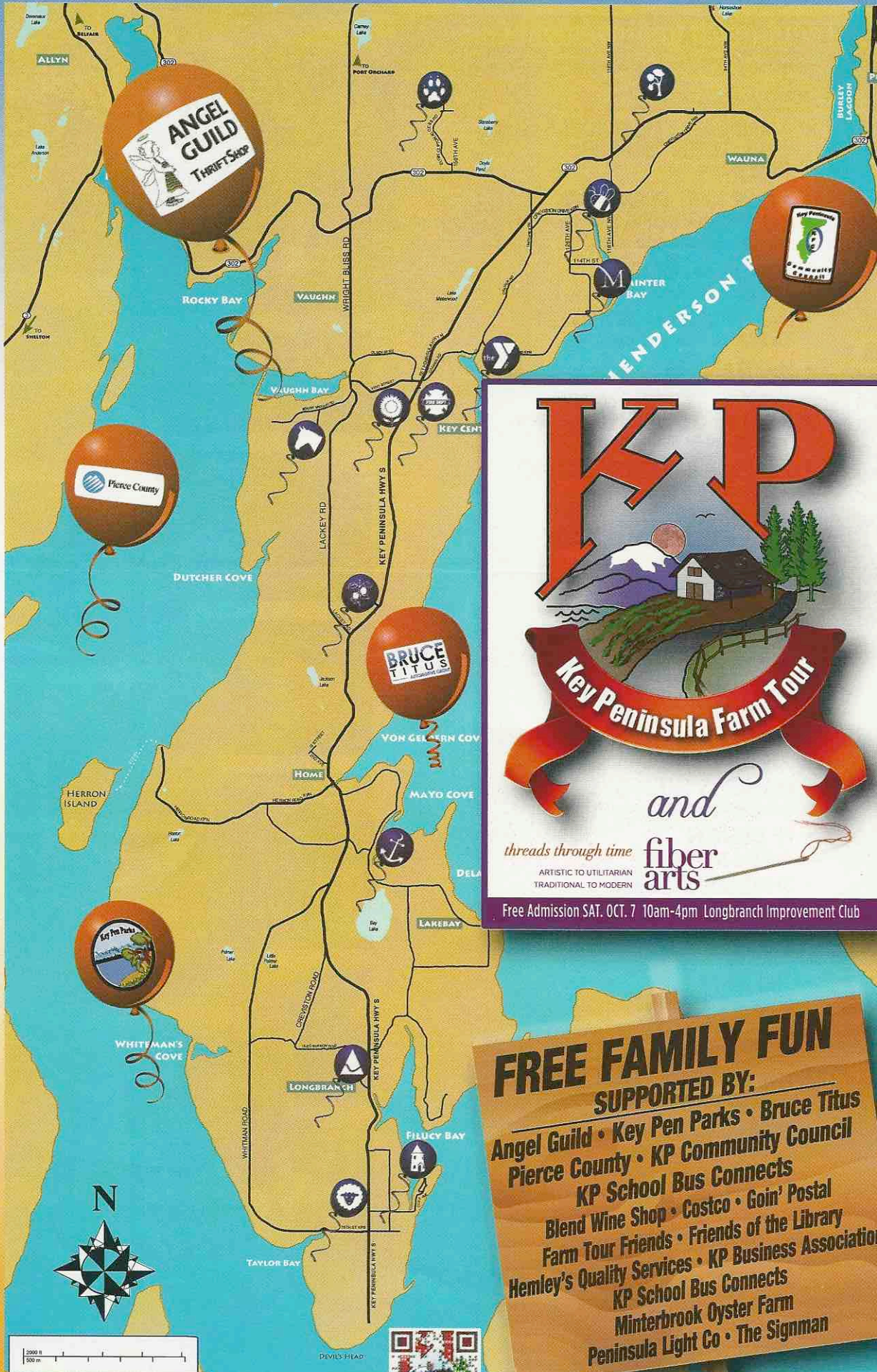

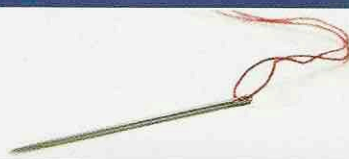

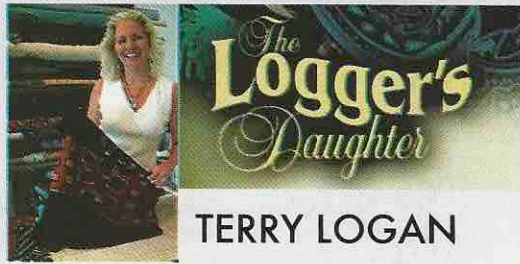
