As you are aware, the Tacoma Plant has been strike-bound since July 15. I know that some of you have been able to obtain employment elsewhere but generally there has been a disruption to normal income. In some cases real hardships have arisen.

Our company and others have tried to bargain with your union but so far there has not been a responsible counter proposal to the various offers. We enclose copy of a report from our company outlining details of the current situation.

If we are to be back at work before Christmas, you must urge your union to do some serious bargaining.
