Dear Mr. Robbins:

Wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter of May 21st in regard to shipment of old mine dumps at Bourne for Mr. C. C. Curl of Pendleton, Oregon. As you are sampling these dumps I believe it would be advisable for you to furnish us with an average sample of four or five pounds which we would have assayed and analyzed in our laboratory and upon which we could base our treatment charges.

In regard to the small dump referred to in your letter, if you would send a sample as soon as possible we would rush it through our laboratory so that we could give you the information as soon as possible. While you are testing the low-grade dumps and working out a suitable process for them, if you could send us a representative sample of the resultant product we could then have a good basis for quoting you terms.
