Shall a Port District be created in Pierce County, which in area will be co-extensive with the limits of said County, as now or hereafter established, for the acquirement, construction, maintenance, operation, development and regulation of a system of harbor improvements and rail and water transfer and terminal facilities, within such district, to be known as the "Port of Tacoma," under the provisions of Chapter 92, Session Laws of Washington, 1911, and under Chapter 62, Session Laws of Washington, 1913.
