

Resolutions passed unanimously by the  
Tacoma, Ministerial Alliance, Dec. 10, 1895.

Whereas certain persons in Tacoma have renewed the unjust and unchristian persecution of the Chinese in our city, interfering with personal liberty in the employment of servants, and tending to oppress the worthy and respectable men who are here from a nation with whom we have valuable commercial and missionary relations:-

Therefore, Resolved, That The Ministerial Alliance of Tacoma wholly disapproves of such interference and persecution:-

And we hereby call upon the authorities of our city to suppress all such movements as threaten the liberty of any of our citizens, or the fomenting of race discord in this civilized city of Tacoma.

We demand that the rights of all be maintained, and that no class prejudice be permitted to prevent our sworn officers from the impartial discharge of their duty, and from the preservation of order and respect for law and for humanity among us.
