Public Meeting ASARCO SMELTER--ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS

Wednesday, May 21, 1975 University of Puget Sound Tacoma, Washington

Remarks by Mayor Gordon N. Johnston City of Tacoma

MR. CHAIRMAN, DISTINGUISHED GUESTS, MY NAME IS GORDON N. JOHNSTON, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TACOMA. FIRSTLY, I WOULD LIKE TO THANK YOU FOR INVITING ME TO COMMENT ON A SUBJECT WHICH IS VERY IMPORTANT TO THE CITY OF TACOMA. IT IS A SUBJECT WHICH IS IMPORTANT BECAUSE OF ITS EFFECT ON OUR LIFESTYLE IN TERMS OF BOTH HEALTH AND ECONOMIC WELL BEING.

AS A PART OF OUR INDUSTRIAL BASE, ASARCO'S
CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE ECONOMY OF TACOMA AND ITS
ENVIRONS IS WELL UNDERSTOOD. A SUBSTANTIAL NUMBER
OF OUR CITIZENS RELY ON THEIR JOBS AT THE ASARCO PLANT
FOR THEIR LIVLIHOOD. AS A PART OF THEIR CIVIC CONCERN
FOR MAINTAINING THIS JOB BASE, THE ASARCO PLANT HAS
MADE SUBSTANTIAL EFFORTS AND PROGRESS IN CLEANING
UP THEIR EMISSIONS TO THE AIR. I HAVE A VERY HIGH
REGARD FOR THESE EFFORTS MADE BY THE OPERATORS OF
THE PLANT.

THE PROBLEMS OF THE AIR POLLUTION CAUSED BY THE OPERATION OF THE PLANT AND THE EFFORTS MADE TO RESOLVE THE PROBLEM HAVE BEEN WELL COVERED IN HEARINGS HELD BY THE PUGET SOUND AIR POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD. AS A MEMBER OF THAT BOARD, MY POSITION ON THE SUBJECT HAS BEEN WELL ESTABLISHED. FOR THAT REASON, TODAY I WOULD LIKE TO TALK A LITTLE ABOUT HOW WE CAN ASSIST THE CITIZENS IN COPING WITH THE PROBLEM OF CONTAMINANTS WHICH HAVE SETTLED ON THE LAND.

THE OPERATION OF THE PLANT OVER THE YEARS
HAS RESULTED IN AIR BORNE CONTAMINANTS SETTLING
ON THE LAND SURROUNDING THE PLANT, IN PARTICULAR
ON THE AREAS DOWNWIND FROM THE PLANT. THESE
CONTAMINANTS HAVE SETTLED ON BOTH PUBLIC AND
PRIVATE PROPERTY.

INSOFAR AS THE PUBLIC PROPERTY IS CONCERNED,
THAT IS, UNPAVED STREETS, THE CITY OF TACOMA HAS
ALREADY COMMENCED A PROGRAM WHICH WILL RESPOND
TO CUTTING DOWN AIR BORNE CONTAMINANTS RAISED BY
DUST FROM THE STREETS. THE CITY COUNCIL HAS THIS

PAST WEEK APPROVED AN INCREASE IN CITY PARTICIPATION FUNDS FOR OILING UNPAVED STREETS. THIS PROGRAM WILL GIVE PARTICULAR EMPHASIS AND PRIORITY TO THOSE STREETS WHICH ARE IN THE AREA OF POTENTIAL HEALTH HAZARDS. FOR EXAMPLE. THE STREETS IN THE VICINITY OF THE ASARCO PLANT THAT HAVE BEEN DETERMINED BY THE PUGET SOUND AIR POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD AS CONTAINING HIGH LEVELS OF DANGEROUS CONTAMINANTS. BECAUSE OF THE METHOD BY WHICH OUR STREET IMPROVE-MENT PROGRAMS ARE ESTABLISHED WHICH REQUIRES RESIDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF PERMANENT STREETS, WE RECOGNIZE THAT OILING THE STREETS IS A SHORT TERM AND ONGOING PROGRAM WHICH THE CITY MUST BE COMMITTED TO. A LONG TERM SOLUTION WILL REQUIRE PARTICIPATION BY THE CITIZENS IN THE PROBLEM AREAS. A STRONG COMMITMENT BY GOVERNMENT AND INDUSTRY TO ASSIST AND ENCOURAGE THOSE RESIDENTS TO COMPLETE THE PROGRAM OF PAVING THE STREETS IS JUST AS IMPORTANT.

ANOTHER AREA OF NEED IS IN REGARDS TO THE USE
OF THE PRIVATE PROPERTY. THE REPORT ISSUED RECENTLY
BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL AND HEALTH
SERVICES ON THE DANGER OF GROWING CERTAIN KINDS
OF VEGETABLES IN CONTAMINATED AREAS INDICATES A
NEED FOR AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM. AS A MEMBER OF
THE TACOMA-PIERCE COUNTY HEALTH BOARD, I WILL BE
PROPOSING TO THE BOARD THAT THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT
INSTITUTE A PUBLIC AWARENESS PROGRAM WHEREIN WE
CAN PROVIDE THE FULLEST AMOUNT OF INFORMATION
NECESSARY FOR THE CITIZENRY TO BE ABLE TO RESPOND
EFFECTIVELY TO THE DANGERS WITHIN THE SOIL OF
THEIR PROPERTIES. COOPERATION FROM OTHER AGENCIES
WILL BE ESSENTIAL IN THIS EFFORT.

IN CLOSING, I WOULD LIKE TO REEMPHASIZE THAT
THE CITY OF TACOMA HAS COMMENCED PROGRAMS TO
BEGIN DEALING WITH THE PROBLEM OF CONTAMINANTS
THAT HAVE BEEN DEPOSITED OVER THE HISTORICAL
RELATIONSHIP THAT ASARCO HAS HAD WITH THE CITY AND

THAT I ENDORSE THE EFFORTS MADE AT THE REGIONAL LEVEL TO CONTINUE THE CLEANING UP OF THE CONTAMINANTS IN THE AIR.
