

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

City Council Chambers, 4:00 P. M.  
Tuesday, April 12, 1966

Council met in regular session. Present on roll call 6: Cvitanich, Finnigan, Haley, Herrmann, Johnson and Mayor Tollefson. Absent 3: Bott, Murtland and Price. Mr. Bott coming in at 4:20 P. M. Mr. Murtland coming in at 4:20 P. M.

Mr. Haley moved that the minutes of the Special meeting of March 28, 1966 be approved as submitted. Seconded by Dr. Herrmann. Voice vote taken. Motion carried.

HEARINGS & APPEALS:

a. This is the date set for hearing on the petition submitted by William M. Busch for the vacation of Puget Sound Ave. between So. Tacoma Way and Montgomery St. and So. 37th between So. Tacoma Way and Union Avenue.

No one appearing and no protests being made, Dr. Herrmann moved that the proper Ordinance be drafted approving the vacation. Seconded by Mr. Johnson. Voice vote taken. Motion carried.

b. This is the date set for hearing on the petition submitted by Reyer and Wick for the vacation of North 22nd St. between Vassault & Defiance Sts.

No one appearing and no protests being made, Mr. Finnigan moved that the proper Ordinance be drafted approving the vacation. Seconded by Mr. Johnson. Voice vote taken. Motion carried.

c. The City Planning Commission recommending denial of the rezoning petition of William M. Busch for a reclassification of the area bounded by Orchard St., Shirley St., 6th Ave. and the alley between So. 8th and So. 9th Streets from an "R-2" and "C-2" to a "C-P-C" District.

An appeal has been filed by the petitioners. Suggested date for hearing is May 10, 1966 at 4:00 P. M.

Dr. Herrmann moved that Tuesday, May 10, 1966 at 4:00 P. M. be set as the date of hearing on the above rezone appeal. Seconded by Mr. Cvitanich. Voice vote taken. Motion carried.

PETITIONS:

Petition submitted by Western Enterprises, Inc. requesting rezoning of property located on the northwest corner of the intersection of So. 47th and Alder Streets from an "R-2" to an "R-4" District.

Referred to the Planning Commission.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution No. 18673

Fixing Tuesday, April 26, 1966 at 4:00 P. M. as the time for hearing on the proposed Zoning Ordinance Text change. (Resubmission of application for amendment, Section 13.06.470.)

Mr. Haley moved that the Resolution be adopted. Seconded by Dr. Herrmann.

The Resolution was passed unanimously by voice vote. Ayes 6; Nays 0; Absent 3, Bott, Murtland and Price.

Resolution No. 18674

Fixing Monday, May 9, 1966 at 4:00 P. M. as the date for hearing on L I D 3620 for sanitary sewers in Defiance and Bristol Sts. from No. 23rd to Westgate Blvd., Whitman St. from No. 23rd to 400 feet south; No. 23rd from Vassault to Defiance Street.

Mr. Finnigan moved that the Resolution be adopted. Seconded by Mr. Haley.

The Resolution was passed unanimously by voice vote. Ayes 6; Nays 0; Absent 3, Bott, Murtland and Price.

Resolution No. 18675

Fixing Monday May 9, 1966 at 4:00 P. M. as the date for hearing on L I D 4783 for alley paving between J and K Streets from So. 21st to So. 23rd and other northend alleys.

Mr. Johnson moved that the Resolution be adopted. Seconded by Mr. Finnigan.

The Resolution was passed unanimously by voice vote. Ayes 6; Nays 0; Absent 3, Bott, Murtland and Price.

FIRST READING OF ORDINANCES:

Ordinance No. 18045

Amending Chapter 13.06 of the official code by adding a new section 13.06.065-53 to include property between Pacific Ave. and Bell St. extended approximately 400 feet south of So. 84th in an "R-4-L" District. (Petition of Television Service Center, Inc. )

The Ordinance was placed in order of final reading.

FINAL READING OF ORDINANCES:

Amending Title II of the official code of the City by amending (29) subsections and repealing (16) subsections of the Traffic Code.
