

MINUTES OF SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

City Council Chambers  
October 2, 1973

Mayor Johnston convened the Special Meeting at 6:17 p.m.

Present on roll call: 6 - Egan, Herrmann, Moss, Nalley, Schuur,  
and Mayor Johnston. Absent: Jarstad and Sonntag. (One Council Vacancy)

Mayor Johnston stated that Mr. Jarstad had advised him that he is  
ill and would not be able to attend the meeting. The Mayor moved to  
excuse Mr. Jarstad from the meeting. Seconded by Dr. Herrmann. Voice  
vote was taken and carried.

Mayor Johnston indicated the prime purpose of the meeting was to  
adjourn into Executive Session to discuss, (1) labor negotiations and  
personnel matters, and (2) the status of a pending law suit.

Mayor Johnston asked City Attorney, Robert Hamilton, about the  
propriety of discussing the pending law suit in Executive Session.  
Mr. Hamilton stated that an Attorney General's opinion of 1971, number  
32, page 23, indicates that cities could utilize this privilege, in this  
case under a modified client-attorney privileged relationship.


Mayor Johnston made a motion to adjourn the meeting into Executive
