

MINUTES OF SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Friday, June 21, 1974

The meeting was called to order at 12:03 p.m. by Mayor Johnston.

Present on roll call: 8 - Egan, Herrmann, Hudson, Moss, Nalley, Neison, Warnick and Mayor Johnston. Absent: 1 - Sonntag.


Mayor Johnston announced that the special meeting had been called to reconsider the hearing date for the Pierce County Homes for Youth Special Use Permit.

Following a brief discussion, Mrs. Egan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hudson, that the hearing date for the Pierce County Homes for Youth Special Use Permit be set for July 2, 1974 rather than July 9th as established at the previous Council meeting.

Mr. Warnick moved an amendment to change the hearing to its original date of June 25th. The motion failed for lack of a second.

Voice vote was taken on Mrs. Egan's motion and carried, with Dr. Herrmann dissenting.

Mrs. Egan moved that the special meeting be adjourned. Seconded by Mr. Nalley. Voice vote was taken and carried. The meeting adjourned at 12:09 p.m.
