MINUTES OF THE BUDGET HEARING

City Council Chambers  
November 14, 1990

Mayor Vialle presided at the meeting and called the budget hearing to order at 5:10 p.m.

Deputy Mayor Stenger called for public testimony on the 1991 - 1992 Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department Preliminary Biennial Budget.


No one appeared from the public to speak.
