Resolution No. 36421

Resolution No. 36422

Authorizing the execution of a collective bargaining agreement with Teamsters Local Union 117, Public Assembly Facilities Unit, which covers 24 employees, effective January 1, 2005, through December 31, 2007.

Resolution No. 36423

Expressing support and urging the Washington State Legislature to adopt the new state Clean Car standards.

Expressing support and recognizing the need for the expansion of the University of Washington, Tacoma to become a four-year college, in order to provide higher education to the citizens of Tacoma.
