MINUTES OF THE BUDGET HEARING

City Council Chambers  
November 13, 1989

Council Member Stenger presided at the meeting and called the public hearing to order at 5:03 p.m.

Council Members present: 6 - McElliott, Mykland, Nielsen, Stenger, Vialle and Warnick. Absent: 3 - Hyde, Moss and Mayor Sutherland.

Council Member Stenger announced that the purpose of the public hearing was to reievew the 1990 Preliminary Budget for the Tacoma-Pierce County Humane Society, the Department of Public Utilities, and the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department.

Council Member Stenger announced that copies of the 1990 Preliminary Department of Public Utilities Budget and the 1990 Department of Public Utilities Budget Summary were available for the public at the back of the Council Chambers.

Council Member Stenger called for public testimony on the Department of Public Utilities Preliminary Budget for 1990.


No one appeared from the public to speak.
