 The Council met in regular session.
 On calling the roll there were present Councilmen Anderson, Quimette, Burns and Robbitt.
 In the absence of the Mayor Mr Quimette was elected president.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.
 The bond of T. B. Louns accompanying his application for a retail liquor license was referred back to him for correction.

 A report was received from the street commissioner.

 Ordered that warrants be drawn on the fiscal funds in favor of the persons and for the amounts specified in the pay roll of the street commissioner accompanying said report.

On motion of Mr. Burns it was ordered that when the council adjourns, it adjourns until 9 o'clock am Jan 5th 1884.

Ordered that the clerk be instructed to notify the several officers of the city to present their final reports to the Council at 9 o'clock am on Jan 5th 1884.

The claim of Jacob Ralph for \$100 for labor and work in December was referred to the Finance Committee.

An Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance establishing the monuments placed by the city surveyor of the City of New Tacoma within the limits of said City during the year 1883" was read the first time.

On Motion said ordinance was read the second time by title.

On Motion the ordinance above mentioned was referred to a committee consisting of Messrs Burns and Anderson for amendment.

Ordered that the street commissioner be authorized to place a hydrant at the corner of 14th street and Pacific Avenue at the expense of the city.

Ordered that the street committee be instructed to procure the completion of the street lighting heretofore ordered on or before next Saturday.

Ordered that the Mayor be authorized to draw with the City for the claim of the city against him for grading & street in front of quarter.

Ordered that warrants be drawn in accordance with the pay roll of the street commissioner and city surveyor.
