## **Briefing Items**

1. <u>19-1094</u> Tideflats Interim Regulations Reauthorization Public Hearing Testimony Summary

At approximately 12:09 p.m., Steve Atkinson, Principal Planner, Planning and Development Services, presented the Tideflats Interim Regulations Reauthorization Public Hearing Testimony summary, including elements of the interim regulations, public testimony, ordinance history, and the Planning Commission's findings.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding existing permit processes, public perception, the State Environmental Policy Act review for fossil fuel industry, timeline of the process, the purpose of the interim regulations, expansions of fossil fuel use in the Tideflats, getting information to partners and the public, and next steps.

## 2. <u>19-1095</u> City Manager's Competency Model

At approximately 12:50 p.m., Mayor Woodards made opening remarks on the City Manager's competency model. Gary Buchanan, Director, Human Resources (HR), explained how the model has been used in the past, what it would look like in this meeting, and introduced Cathy Journey, Senior Manager, and Georgia Lewis, HR Specialist, HR. Ms. Journey presented the competency model, including the definition of a competency,

navigating through the deck of competency cards, position profile questions, the job profile card sort, and the card sort results for both mission critical competencies and less important competencies.

The Mayor and Council Members participated in the competency-sorting exercise and discussion ensued regarding ranking the competencies for evaluation of the City Manager position.
