

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

April 21, 1980

The Special Meeting was called to order at 6:18 p.m. by Deputy Mayor Nielsen.

Present on roll call: 6 - Bichsel, Hawkins, Kirby, Nielsen, Rasmussen and Sutherland. Absent: 2 - Strege and Mayor Parker. Councilman Strege arrived at 6:19 p.m.

The Flag Salute was led by Deputy Mayor Nielsen.

Deputy Mayor Nielsen announced that the purpose of the Special Meeting consisted of only one agenda item and that was the continuation of the interviews of prospective candidates to fill Councilman Evans' vacancy on the Council.
