MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES BUDGET HEARING

City Council Chambers  
November 18, 1987

Deputy Mayor Rasmussen called the public hearing to order at 5:04 p.m.

Council members present: 5 - Hyde, McElliott, Neilsen, Warrnick, and Deputy Mayor Rasmussen. Absent: 4 - Moss, Mykland, Stenger and Mayor Sutherland.

Deputy Mayor Rasmussen announced that the purpose of the public hearing was to review the 1988 Preliminary Budget for the Department of Public Utilities. He stated that copies of both the 1988 Preliminary Budget and the 1988 Budget Summary for the Department of Public Utilities were available to the public at the back of the Council Chambers.

The Deputy Mayor also announced that this was a regular, advertised public hearing and that notice had been duly published and should be incorporated by reference into the record.

Mr. Ted Coates made a presentation on the introductory portion of the budget and, in turn, introduced Mr. Dennis Nixon, Budget Officer for the Department of Public Utilities, who reviewed the 1988 budget for the Department.

Deputy Mayor Rasmussen then called for public testimony on the Department of Public Utilities Preliminary Budget for 1988.
