

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

City Council Chambers
September 23, 1988

The meeting was called to order at 12:30 p.m.

Present on roll call: 7 - Hyde, McElliott, Moss, Mykland, Nielsen, Vialle,
and Mayor Sutherland. Absent: 2 - Stenger and Warnick. (Council Member
Warnick arrived at 12:32 p.m.)

Mayor Sutherland announced that this was a special City Council meeting
and that proper notice had been given as required by state law. He also
stated that the topic of the meeting would be limited to the Emergency Medical
Services special levy as previously advertised.

Council Member Warnick arrived at 12:32 p.m.

Mayor Sutherland then read the notice calling for the special meeting as
follows:

That, in accordance with Section 2.8 of the Official Charter of
the City of Tacoma, a special meeting is hereby called for
Friday, September 23, 1988, at the hour of 12:30 p.m., to be held
in the Council Chambers in the Tacoma Municipal Building,
747 Market Street, Tacoma, Washington, for the purpose of
considering the adoption of an emergency ordinance, submitting a
proposition to the qualified voters of the City of Tacoma, for
their approval or rejection, providing for the authority to levy
an additional regular property tax for emergency medical care, at
the election to be held on November 8, 1988.
